Families, please come and join us for a shared learning experience on Friday, October 19th, from 9:00-9:30. This will be an opportunity to join your child's classroom and engage in the learning or the school happenings, with them.

What to expect:

- To sit with your child as they go about their 9:00-9:30 school events. You can engage in what they are engaging in or support them in their learning. For example, if the class is doing math during that time...grab a pencil and paper ☺ and work along with them. If the class is reading during that time...choose a great book from the classroom library and read along with them. If the class happens to be music or PE...I hope you brought along your singing voice and running shoes. ☺

What not to expect:

- To sit at the back of the room to observe.
- To have a conference with the teacher.
- To only support your child. We will strongly encourage you to talk with, and possibly share knowledge with, students who sit near your child. Not all parents will be able to make it, so it would be great to share this experience with the whole class.
- To have the teacher change up his, or her, plans for this event. Our goal is for you to be more organically part of the learning space.
- To be a guest speaker for the class.
- To bring your whole family. Sorry, but we can't accommodate for the space needed for more than one family member per student. If you have multiple children at Lake Ridge, different family members can come so each child has a representative. Or you can split the time between your children's classrooms.

We know that classes start at 8:45 AM and many of you drop students off in the morning. If you would like to not have to come back at 9:00, you can head down to Room 131, to wait until 9:00. If you would like to go outside to play with your child before the bell rings, great! Just head down to Room 131 when the bell rings, to wait for the 9:00 shared learning space start time. Giving the teachers these 15 minutes will allow them to get students settled in, and their attendance and lunch count done, in a timely manner.

Also, as always, you will need to stop by the office for a Visitor's Pass.
